## Explore the rock carving keepers

The subterranean stone house sheds light on the early domestic lives of the tribesmen and the origins of the annual "Tangidrakakalane".

The mountain meanders, Taiwan oil millet cookies, purple crow butterflies, stone carving and rubbing, etc, constitute the cultural symbol of the Zhoukou River – Oponoho.

# Kaohsiung Kunadavan (Duona)



## The town of black rice and warrior

The Kongadavange called their settlement Kunadavan. The traditional Rukai culture has been well preserved, with stone slab houses, Rukai totems, and stone sculptures dotting the landscape. As you move through the tribe's streets, you may come across the human sacrifice altar, the warrior call platform, the warrior's trail, and other locations that transport you back to the tribe's earlier hunting expeditions.

There is a wide and flat plateau in the mountains behind the tribe where the unique black rice is grown. The black rice festival (Tabesengane) is held every year to pray for a good harvest in the coming year.
