## About the tour

The bike route is located along county highway 185 in Sandimen Township; it is the earliest developed tourist bike route in Pingtung County. With beautiful scenery and aboriginal tribes, this bike route has always been one of the riders' favorite routes. The tour includes visiting three major tribes along the route: Auba, Qingshan, and Djineljepan. A variety of bikes, including extremely lightweight carbon fiber bikes, aluminum alloy bikes and general bikes, are available for tourists to choose from. Accompanied by local tour guides, you can experience the mysterious forest and interesting toys, as well as find new ways to enjoy the tour of the tribes.

# Kabalhelajan

The tribe is located in the circular plateau in the center of the mountain called "Xia Wutai"; it is the administrative center of Wutai Township. Most residents in the tribe are Rukai people, whose innate artistic talents are fully expressed in their living environment. Both their architecture and artistic sculptures are amazing. The industrial development is also quite active. Delicious food restaurants, special workshops and accommodations are all very complete.

# About the tour

To promote tribal cuisine, the Kabalhelajan founded the first tribal cooking school in Taiwan. Through courses offered by the school, visitors are able to carry out the cooking process, from learning about the ingredients to collecting them and cooking. During the learning process, they can also use a variety of handmade tribal style tableware. By satisfying visitors' five senses via the tour, the Kabalhelajan conveys the most authentic Rukai food culture to them.

The shouting stone was also the place where the chieftain announced major events.

### About the tour


