Pingbei cycling tour - recording tribal scenery with bikes

The tribe moved from Dashe to the current location along the Meiren Mountain. Recently, it has developed toys-experiencing activities and cultural and creative products. Furthermore, the vacant spaces were planned to be the area for toys-experiencing activities.

About the tour

The bike route is located along county highway 185 in Sandimen Township; it is the earliest developed tourist bike route in Pingtung County. With beautiful scenery and aboriginal tribes, this bike route has always been one of the riders' favorite routes. The tour includes visiting three major tribes along the route: Auba, Qingshan, and Djineljeapan. A variety of bikes, including extremely lightweight carbon fiber bikes, aluminum alloy bikes and general bikes, are available for tourists to choose from. Accompanied by local tour guides, you can experience the mysterious forest and interesting toys, as well as find new ways to enjoy the tour of the tribes.

SABAUI! Fall in love with the tribal cooking school!

The tribe is located in the circular plateau in the center of the mountain called "Xia Wutai"; it is the administrative center of Wutai Township. Most residents in the tribe are Rukai people, whose innate artistic talents are fully expressed in their living environment. Both their architecture and artistic sculptures are amazing. The industrial development is also quite active. Delicious food restaurants, special workshops and accommodations are all very complete.

About the tour

To promote tribal cuisine, the Kabalhelajan founded the first tribal cooking school in Taiwan. Through courses offered by the school, visitors are able to carry out the cooking process, from learning about the ingredients to collecting them and cooking. During the learning process, they can also use a variety of hand-made tribal style tableware. By satisfying visitors' five senses via the tour, the Kabalhelajan conveys the most authentic Rukai food culture to them.

Flower world of Lakaraw - Paiwan Headwear Culture

The tribe is located in the former site of Paiwan Village, which is the birthplace of the Paiwan. There is a complete slate house group in the tribe. Among them, the chieftain's house is the largest. There are an ancestral pillar, burial pit, and skylight inside the house. There is also a shouting stone. In ancient times, messages were sent to distant tribes through shouting. The shouting stone was also the place where the chieftain announced major events.

About the tour

The tribe is located between mountains. There is no electricity and no signal in the area. Visiting here, you will feel like being in an isolated world, and can enjoy your undisturbed time. The tribe features Paiwan headwear culture. Visitors can deepen their understanding of the Paiwan headwear through identifying and collecting flowers, experiencing headwear production, and learning cultural meaning.

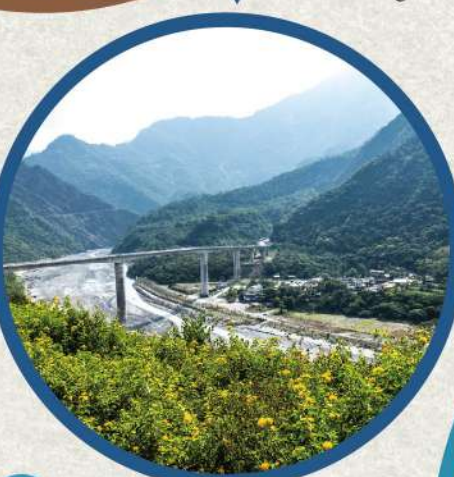

Burn! My tribal baking soul!

The Maolin Tribal Environmental Education Center is the only certified purple spot butterflies ecological area in Taiwan. To promote tourism during the non-butterfly season, the tour combines the tribal cultural experience with environmental education, hoping to acquaint visitors with local agricultural products, enable them to learn how to make specialty snacks, and obtain a deep understanding of the tribal history.

About the tour

The Maolin tribe combines environmental education with the tribal baking industry, allowing travelers to not only experience the charm of the Maolin Valley Waterfall, but also observe the tribal ecological environment in the summer. In addition, experience courses from the tribal baking school allow visitors to learn about the unique ingredients of the tribe, such as Formosa lambs-quarters and millet, creating different tribal experiences for the summer Maolin.

Tea etiquette in mountains! Enjoy the tribal tea party!

The Baoshan tribe includes Yijituan, Ejrituan and Tengjih. Residents here are mostly Bunun people; their specialties include native camellia, oolong tea, peach, plum, etc. The climate is cool and pleasant. With the foggy weather lasting for six months, the tribe is definitely the best place to enjoy forest bathing and good tea.

About the tour

The tribe has the original camellia trees left from the Japanese occupation period. They are located at an altitude of 1,200m~1,600m. Due to the foggy environment, the tribe brews the best tea. In recent years, the tribe started to adopt a friendly farming method, creating a tribe with a theme of native camellia. The tribe also uses elements of the Bunun culture to develop special tea sets and explain the tea etiquette and culture to help tourists enjoy its leisure atmosphere.

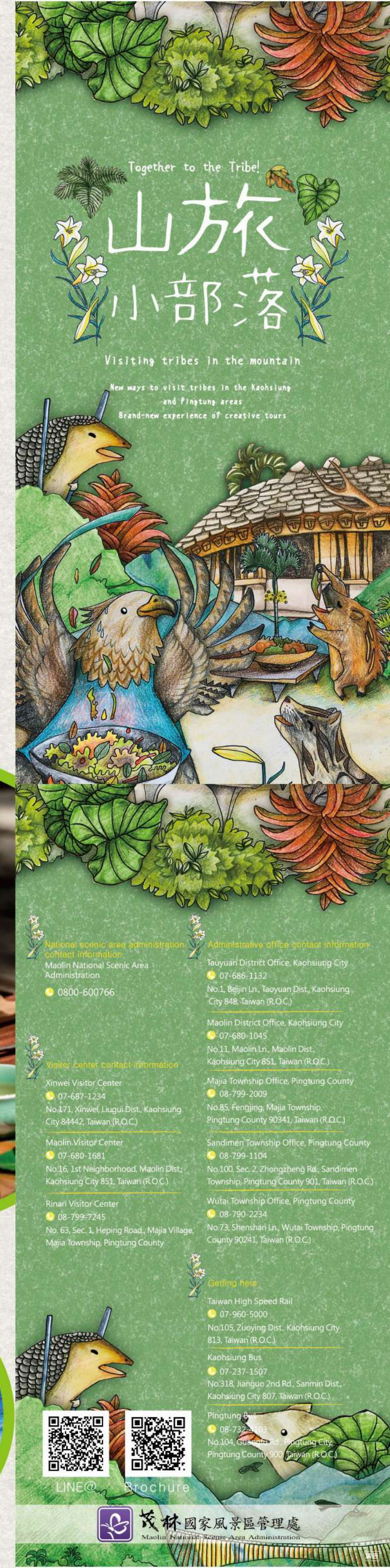
